- 1. Cover Page** – Project Title, your name, class, date, subject.
- 2. Introduction** – Brief details about the documentary or podcast and why you chose it.
- 3. Summary/Podcast Script** – Describe the content, script, or key events in your own words.
- 4. Observations /Analysis** – Highlight key points, interesting facts, lessons, or opinions.

5. Reflection – Share what you learned, what inspired you, and what you liked the most.

6. Illustration- Also add a poster, flowchart, mind map or slogan related to the documentary/podcast.

Note- A-4 size sheets are to be used for the Project Work.

Topic: Patterns in Mathematics and Architecture

1. Look for patterns in the world around you, specifically in mathematics and architecture. Think about shapes, symmetry, repetition, or tessellations you see in tiles, walls, floors, or buildings.
 - Draw or paste a **photograph** of an example of a pattern you found.
 - Explain the pattern you have identified.
 - Describe how this pattern relates to **mathematical concepts (like geometry, symmetry, etc.)**.
2. Create a colourful design on an A-4 size sheet using **mathematical patterns** such as symmetry, repetition or tessellation and explain it.

Note- A-4 size sheets are to be used for the Project Work.
