पेड़-पौधों का जीवन चक्र

परियोजना कार्य :

👉 Terrarium Making – Simple Steps

1. Take a clean transparent jar or container.
2. Add small stones at the bottom for drainage.
3. Add a thin layer of charcoal (optional).

7. Spray a little water.
8. Keep the terrarium in indirect sunlight.
