SCIENCE -

students can prepare innovative models or chart on **any one** of the following themes:

- Environment Sustainability – Related to saving nature and reducing pollution such as rainwater harvesting, solar energy, recycling, or eco-friendly cities.
- Transportation and Innovation – Showing modern and smart transport systems like electric vehicles, smart traffic signals, metro systems, or future transportation ideas.
- Hydroponic Farming – Based on growing plants without soil using nutrient-rich water, promoting modern and sustainable farming techniques

SOCIAL SCIENCE -

Prepare a questionnaire consisting of 10 questions related to the Voter ID Card and the voting process. After preparing the questionnaire, students must interview any three family members or adults in their neighborhood and mention their responses neatly with separate 3 respondent sheets and then prepare a consolidated report by analysing the responses for the same. The report should include the names, ages, opinions and pictures of the interviewees regarding the importance of voting and voter awareness. In addition, students have to design and make a sample Voter ID Card creatively using chart paper or craft material.

OR

Students are required to visit any one heritage site in Delhi built during the Mughal or Delhi Sultanate period, such as Qutub Minar, Humayun's Tomb, Red Fort, etc. During the visit, they must create a video of the site and add a voice-over explaining its historical importance and key features. They are also required to interview at least one person at the site who has knowledge about the monument and click pictures for the same. After completing the visit, prepare a detailed report talking about its Historical and Political significance along with the video and pictures of the interviewee as well. A4 size sheets and stick file to be used for interview and respondent sheets.
